- ❖ Low Cost Construction Technology

Submission Guideline

- ❖ Proposals of Research output-based community activity projects are preferred.
- ❖ The project proposals should be intervention based and expected to improve community problems; E.g. Community Based Sheep breeding program, Community Based School level Improvement, Health Centres, projects like DTP, ETP, in Health and Medicine College
- ❖ The projects should encourage the engagement of community, researchers and other stakeholder if any.



- ❖ Training proposals are not encouraged, rather community need driven trainings requested by either office, Governmental and NGO's will be entertained based on its relevance and feasibility study.
- ❖ It shouldn't be based on quota system for each college; the focus should be on the benefits of community at large.
- ❖ It should be interdisciplinary.
- ❖ Voluntary project proposals are encouraged.
- ❖ Researchers implementing unpaid community services will be certified.
- ❖ The members of a project proposal should not exceed 5.
- ❖ A researcher can only participate in maximum two community service proposals.
- ❖ The maximum pages of the proposal should be 15-20, Time New Roman 12, Regular, Justified, Margin 1 inch, line spacing 1.5.
