Preface

Education is the basis of all development. All kinds of developments like political, economic, social, and technological are the result of the education developments. Without education, no kind of development can be achieved throughout the world. To ensure the benefit of citizens' in terms of education, for the last years, the FDRE government has been undertaking various educational reforms. One of those development reforms is the equitable expansion of education institutions and infrastructures throughout the country. Accordingly, the FRDE government is undertaking large-scale activities at the national level by opening higher education institutions and various educational programs to ensure access to education and respond to the educational needs of the people. As one of the education institutions' expansion projects, the foundation stone of Wachmo University was laid in 2003 E/C by the former Prime Minister of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia, Meles Zenawi (Pictured below)



The laying of this foundation stone solved one of the centuries-old infrastructure development questions of the Hadiya people and opened the new door to the other development projects. Dr. Solomon became the first president of Wachemo University. Following this, WCU has officially started the teaching and learning process in 2004 E/C with 538 students in 12 departments. However, the start of the teaching process was not an easy task because of the lack of teaching facilities and manpower. Regardless, at the time, the teaching and learning process was temporarily started in Hosanna College of Teacher Education and Hosanna Polytechnic College

Since it was in its infant stage, there were ups and downs in terms of infrastructure and manpower. Regardless of these facts, the first president of the University, Dr. Solomon Eyob has played significant role for the establishment of the university. After he served as President, Dr. Mandefero Eshetie, the second president of Wachemo University, was appointed as the President of the University and he successfully led the University for 3 years. The 3rd president of the university was Dr. Tassew Gebre. He took over the presidency and served as the head of the university for three consecutive years. All above mentioned presidents played significant role in the success of the university and contributed greatly for its current status. The 4th and current president of the university is Dr. Habtamu Abebe who has done and is doing great deal of works during his presidency. For this reason, this short communication basically discusses the reform activities which have been done during the presidency of Dr. Habtamu Abebe.

About the University

Wachemo University is one of the comprehensive public higher educational institutions established in 2004 E.C with the mandate of teaching, research, and community services. It is located 230 km southwest of Addis Ababa, at Hossana town in an area of over 200 hectares. The university is dedicated to providing quality education, conduct demand-driven research, and cater need-based community services. It is headed by the President and four Vice Presidents including Academic Affairs, Research and community services, Business and Development, and Students' Affair and Administrative. The University commenced its function in 2012 admitting 538 students in 12 departments under 4 colleges.

Currently, the University admitted over 27, 000 students in regular and continuing education programs in 54 departments under 6 Colleges and 3 Schools: Engineering and Technology, Natural and Computational Sciences, Medicine and Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Business and Economics, and Social Sciences and Humanities and School of Law, School of Veterinary Medicine and School of Graduate Studies (SGS), respectively. In addition to this, the university has been launching new programs in both undergraduate and postgraduates.

The University has 1457 academic staff (36 are expatriates) more than 40 technical support staff and more than 1000 administrative staff. In addition to this, the university has launched its campus at Durame town (Kambata Tambaro Zone) about 100Km away from the Main campus, Nigist Elen Muhammed Memorial Comprehensive Specialized Hospital which is a teaching Hospital; found at Hossana town, Shone CEP center about 120km away

from the main campus, Homecho CEP center which is 38km away from the main campus, Gimbichu CEP center which is 32km from the main campus, Mudula CEP center about 105km from the main campus and Gilgel Gibe center which mainly focuses on Electrical and Power Engineering fields about 125km far from the main campus. In addition to this, it has been playing pioneering roles by reaching the community through research and community services. To mention some of them, it funds more than 130 research projects yearly along with other thematic research projects which spawn more than 3 years.

The number of academic staff involved in research and community services and the number of research and community services proposals/projects, which are sponsored by the university, have been increasing and broadening its scope from year to year. To reach the community through research and community services, the university has established seven Research and Technology Transfer centers in the catchment areas: main campus, Shone research center, at shone town, Lambuda research center at Lemo woreda, Buima research center at Misha Woreda, Shonkola research center at Soro Woreda, and Orcha research center at Mirab Soro Woreda.

To disseminate scholarly research outputs and findings to the stakeholders, the university has been working strongly to establish and launch the university's academic journal and already started some of the preliminary activities. It is believed that scholarly publishing is very important in research and academia. Hence, it aims to meet the publication and dissemination needs of locally emerging researchers, which in turn will increase the ranking of WCU in terms of research and community service within the competing peers. Quality and generic publishing promote and raise the overall profile of the institution and outstand-

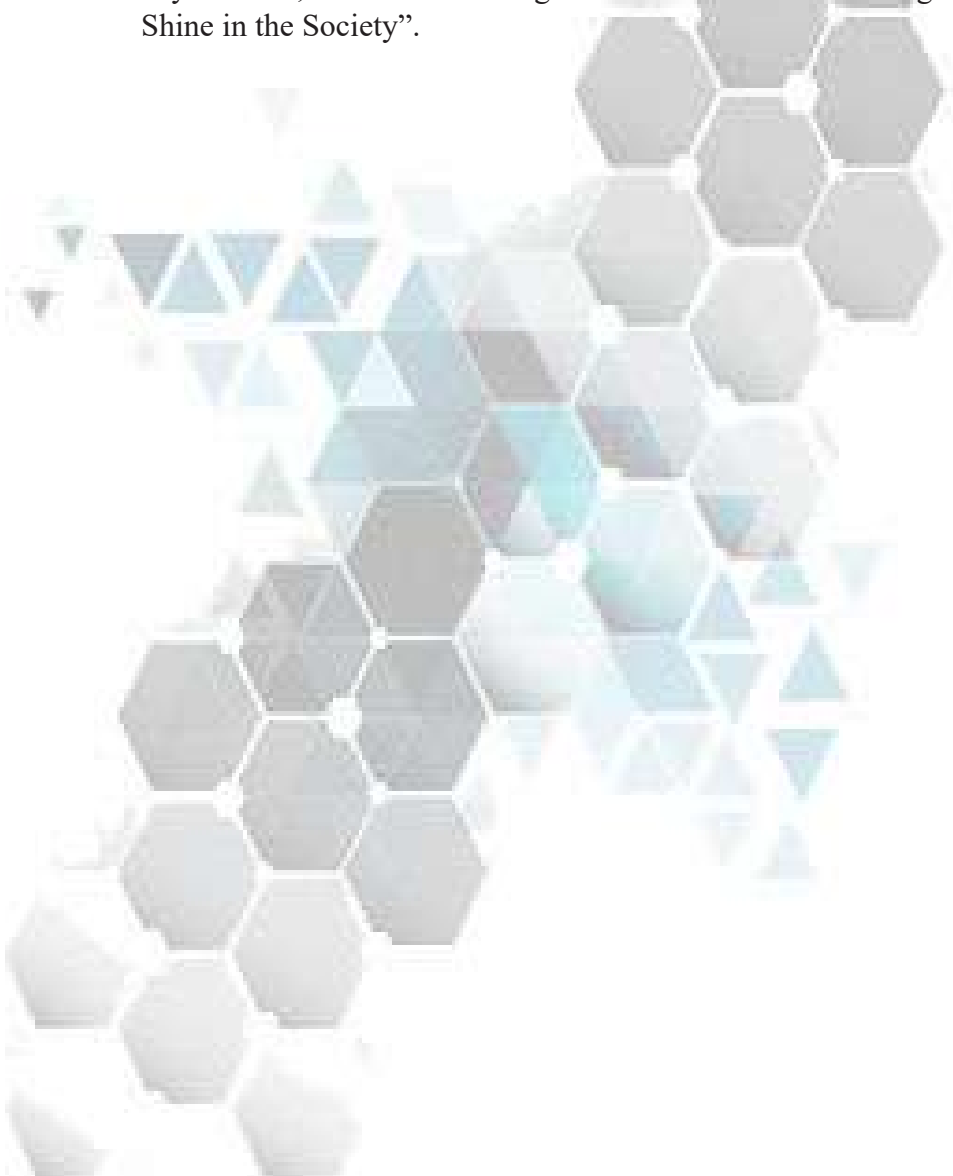
ing scientific publishing and creative works at WCU will add to the global knowledge and increase acceptance in the global research community.

The other governing principle of the university is creating a conducive and attractive environment for all community members of the university. On top of this, the university provided residence houses with internet services for some of the academic staff in two sites at Hossana town and striving to build additional apartments within the main campus. Professional capacity building is the other mandate of the university. In this regard, it has been providing national and international MA and PhD degree opportunity for most of our academic staff. In terms of international relations, the university signed memorandum of understanding with Youth Fellowship (Korea), India and Free State University (South Africa).

Most importantly, the university has been working strongly to ensure peace and security to students by preaching the principle of “Unity in Diversity” where it boldly stressed peaceful co-existence, religious diversity, socio-cultural diversity, language diversity, various values and norms of the students. Thus, with the cumulative effort of the community members of the university, we ensured peace and security in the main campus, Campuses and CEP coordination Centers. Therefore, we proudly call our university “Peace Ambassador”.

Generally, in all these aspects, we believe that Wachemo University plays a pioneering role in making a valuable contribution to the overall development of Ethiopia in general and the catchment area in particular. Based on the above facts, the university is striving to become one of the top ten universities in Ethiopia and home of the brilliants by 2017 E. C. Therefore,

all the community members of WCU with their profundity and commitment are playing an immense role to achieve the university's vision, and mission along with its motto "Let Your Light Shine in the Society".

Some Reform Works at WCU (2011-2014 E.C)

There has been several reform works that are being accomplished at Wachemo University since the emerging of new leadership at 2010 E.C. The major reform works are in the area of constructions and infrastructures, good governance, academic programs expansion, Research and Technology Centres Expansion, National and International Public relations and attachments, peace and security and establishing attractive teaching learning environment, establishment of recreation centres, ICT infrastructure expansions for both the staff and students at large.

Infrastructures

Since the coming of the new leadership into seat, there has been handful of institutional transformations in the main campus and other campuses. To mention some of these reform activities, fence buildings (Main campus, Durame campus, Nigist Elleni Comprehensive Teaching Hospital, Research and Technology transfer centers, ICT infrastructure, Asphalt road Construction, Oxygen production machine plantation, students and staff cafeteria expansion and reconstruction, laboratory equipment installation and COVID-19 test machine purchase... etc. Campus infrastructure is evolving to support innovative approaches to

learning and teaching and other manoeuvres in the university.



ICT Infrastructure

Teaching and learning can further be improved by replacing of conventional teaching instead of the usual age old method of chalk and talk for teaching by innovative methods like power point presentations and animations, modelling and simulations, video clips and using AV aids, LCD projectors etc. In addition to this, ICT in administration of educational institutions play a major role in efficient utilization of existing resources and simplifies the administration tasks (e.g. in student administration, staff administration, general administration etc.) by reducing the paper work and replaces the manual maintenance of record keeping to electronic maintenance of records which helps in easy retrieval of any information of students, staff and general with in a fraction of seconds can access the required information. Furthermore, integration of ICT in higher education enhances the quality of research work and more number of individuals enrolled in the research work in various fields. ICT facilitates

the links across the world in all subject matter and made social networking. It saves time, money and effort to the researchers in their research studies.

By considering above mentioned facts, Wachemo University commenced to implement a huge project on ICT (broad band and Wi-Fi and broad band internet service at offices, dormitories and staff residences).

Moreover, surveillance camera is at different spots to control each and every movement. On the other hand, smart rooms, high tech resolution rooms, and other latest technology friendly infra-structures are under process.

Asphalt Road Construction

Traditional Medicinal Plants Conservation and developments

Traditional Medicines are age old cultural disease treatment mechanisms in most of Ethiopian Societies. Long before the introduction of modern hospitals and clinics in Ethiopia, people have been using traditional medicines by using indigenous healing knowledge acquired through trial and error methods. The new road map on traditional medicine has defined traditional medicine as the sum total of knowledge, skills and practices on holistic healthcare, recognized and accepted by the community for its role in the maintenance of health and the treatment of

disease. Traditional medicine is based on the theory, belief and experiences that are indigenous to the different cultures, and that is developed and handled down from generation to generation. In the African region, this knowledge is handled down mostly by oral tradition.

In the Ethiopian context, a large segment of the population relied for centuries on a system of traditional or indigenous health care for treating various ailments. This is often linked to its multi-ethnic and cultural diversity coupled with the various physical environments which fosters an array of unique flora and fauna. Traditional medicine is an integral part of the local culture that is affordable and accessible even when there is demonstrably efficient and less costly alternative modern health care. Medicinal plants originated from traditional medicine are also obviously alternate candidate products as income source and improving the livelihood for the community. Traditional medicine could also contribute for the national economy through export of raw or processed medicinal plants for rendering foreign currency. Traditional medicine could contribute a significant role in the health care through improved policy, research and development efforts of multidisciplinary experts in integrated manner.

Ministry of Health recently has approved a policy that treats traditional medicines as alternative medicines. The approval of this new policy road map would serve as fertile ground for our research and community service works. It would a great input for the researchers who would do further work on the traditional medicinal plants. On the other hand, Wachemo University is committed to conduct a thematic research in the area by conserving traditional medicinal plants in the farms, and training the traditional healers. Therefore, this project proposal is aimed to do the conservation, thematic research, and community service works on traditional medicines that are found at Hadiya and Kembta Tembaro Zones and other areas as well.

There could be different reasons to execute this project at Wachemo University. First of all, traditional medicines are less researched field of studies as compared to other field of researches in our country. Secondly, Africa is the richest and most endowed continent with traditional medicinal plants which has been practiced for centuries. Thirdly, our university has got young and energetic staff members who are able to manage such project under different college.

Wachemo University has been designing and implementing various projects since its establishment. By now the university is vigorously working on traditional medicinal plants known as herbal medicine. This is a project that aims at conserving medicinal plants and conducting lab based researches on traditional medicinal plants found under the catchment area of Wachemo University in particular and outside the catchment as well. On the other hand, it is a project that will be implemented in collaboration with traditional healers, biodiversity institution experts, researchers, different governmental and non-governmental institutions.

Establishment of Cultural Museum

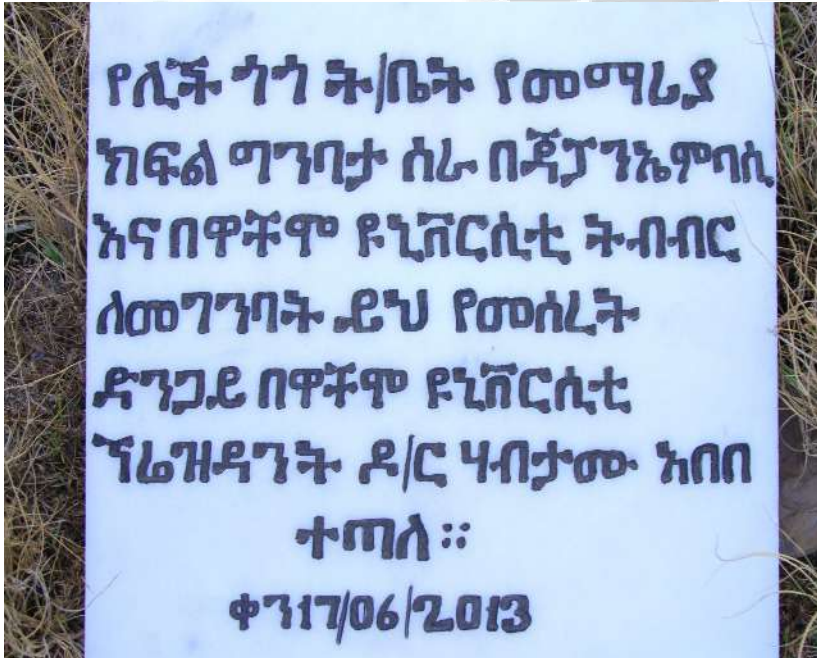

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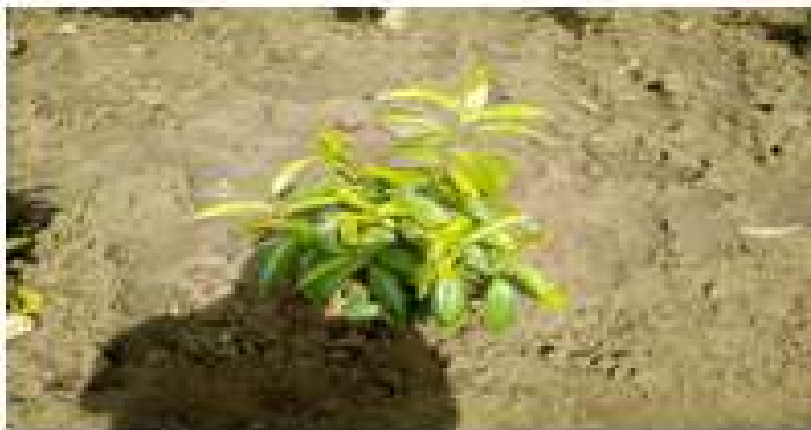
